I. Questions with was, were, could.

Were you at the party yesterday?
Where was Peter last night?
Why couldn't Sue come last Friday?

If there is no other auxiliary verb, use DID in questions in the past tense

- Did he work last summer?
- Did they see him yesterday?
- Did Anna come home after the meeting?
- Did Jack find his books in the box?





Note!!!

Word order: DID + subject + infinitiv

- Did you like playing chess as a child?
- What time did the workers finish the instalation?
- Did John really unveil his plans to build a house?

Write questions using these sentences:

- Jill had a sandwich for lunch.
- The maths test was difficult.
- The children liked their French lessons.
- Dad said he was good at geography.

- Was the maths test difficult?
- Did the children like their French lessons?
