

Questions in the past tense



I. Questions with *was*, *were*, *could*.

- Were you at the party yesterday?
- Where *was* Peter last night?
- Why *couldn't* Sue come last Friday?

If there is no other auxiliary verb, use *DID* in questions in the past tense

- Did he work last summer?
- Did they see him yesterday?
- Did Anna come home after the meeting?
- Did Jack find his books in the box?



Note!!!

Word order:

DID + subject + infinitiv

- Did you like playing chess as a child?
- What time did the workers finish the instalation?
- Did John really unveil his plans to build a house?

Write questions using these sentences:

- Jill *had* a sandwich for lunch.
- The maths test was difficult.
- The children *liked* their French lessons.
- Dad *said* he was good at geography.



Keys:

- Did Jill **have** a sandwich for lunch?
- Was the maths test difficult?
- Did the children **like** their French lessons?
- Did dad **say** that he was good at geography?
